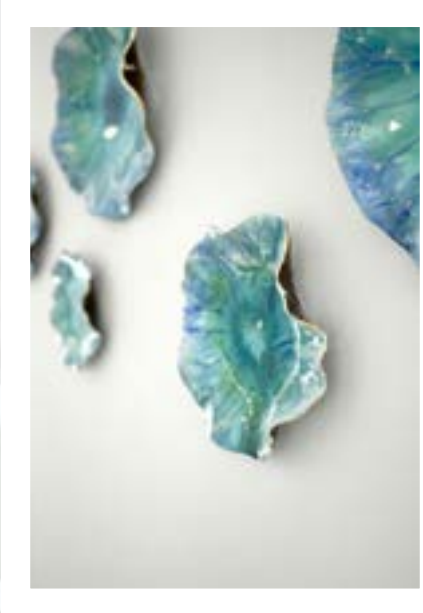
The Role of an Interior Designer

What To Expect When Working With an Interior Designer

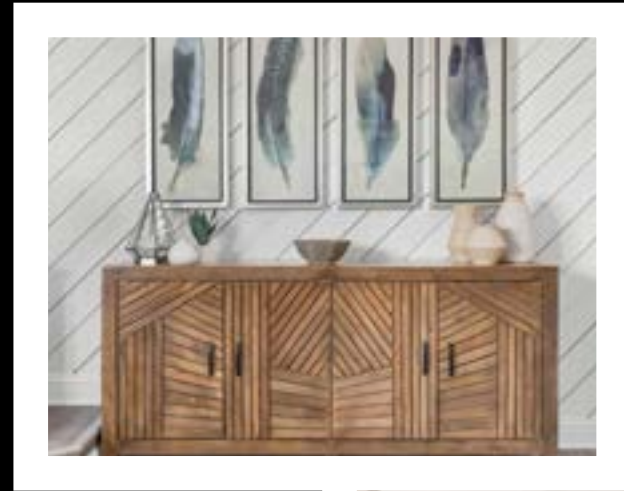

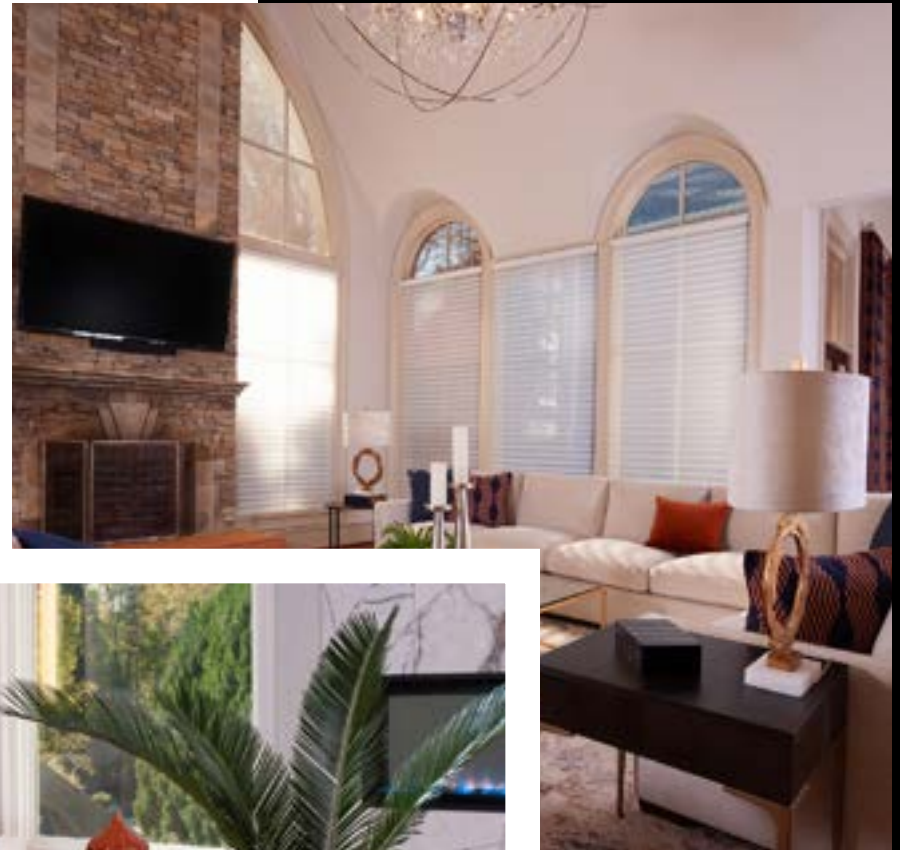
This design blueprint is then presented to you in a second meeting, where you discuss the presentation and make any necessary adjustments or changes to the plan.
